### Easter Sunday (Year A)

11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> April 2020

Dear Friends,

We step out of Lent with its darker penitential side into the brightness of Easter. One of the first sounds we hear is that of running feet. There is the breathless Mary Magdalene grasping her discovery of an empty tomb. Her news brings Peter and John running to the tomb, the younger John out-running Peter, handicapped by age and guilt. Peter the first to enter the tomb, to see and believe. Later downhearted disciples left an unfinished meal at Emmaus to hurry back to tell that they had seen Jesus. Disciples heading back to what they had left, an ungenerous land, the fickle sea, the ordinary lives that they had left for an extraordinary man.

Running feet bring an urgent message of Easter joy: THE LORD IS RISEN. But we live in a time and place far removed from the Gospel. It's hard to be joyful when your heart is empty, when you look at an empty chair rather than an empty tomb. Due to the Coronavirus people are in danger of losing their jobs, businesses are going bankrupt there seems little to return to, money is short and our future is filled with uncertainty.

But if we believe in the RESURRECTION, we have faith that we are precious to the God who pursues us, even into the grave, to give us life. All around us lie the signs of hope, the earth stirring with new life; the seed sown in hope fulfils its promise. In Queens hospital, we see Doctors and Nurses putting their life on the line caring for patients, giving hope to them.

As we look into the empty tomb, with our individual emptiness, let us pray that Christ will nudge us awake to hope. In him we have a reason for hope, a reason to live; because He lives. Wishing you all God's blessing this Easter time.
