The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary & Joseph (Year B)

26th & 27th December 2020

Dear Friends.

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. We meditate on St Joseph's role within the family. This year Pope Francis has written an apostolic letter entitled "Patris Corde (With a Father's Heart)" The Holy Father wrote Patris Corde against the backdrop of the covid-19 pandemic, which, he says, has helped us see more clearly the importance of "ordinary" people who, though far from the limelight, exercise patience and offer hope every day. In this they resemble St Joseph, "the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence," who nonetheless played "an incomparable role in the history of salvation." In his letter, he said, "Fathers are not born, but made. A man does not become a father simply by bringing a child into the world, but by taking up the responsibility to care for that child." Unfortunately, in today's society, children "often seem orphans, lacking fathers" who are unable to introduce them "to life and reality." Happiness for Joseph involved a true gift of self, "In him, we never see frustration, but only trust. His patient silence was a prelude to concrete expressions of trust." Joseph stands out, therefore, as an exemplary figure for our time, in a world that "needs fathers," and not "tyrants". Joseph was able to turn a problem into a possibility by trusting in divine providence. He had to deal with concrete problems, as many family faces today like unemployment, housing and trying to provide for their families. Therefore, today we ask the Holy Family to pray for us. We will be saying the prayer at the back of this newsletter each day from the 1st January 2021.
