Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B) 12th & 13th June 2021

Dear Friends,

Everybody knows that if you plant an acorn in the ground, given time it will grow into an oak tree, yet nobody knows how, and extraordinary that a huge oak should have such humble origins. Jesus says this is how it is with the reign of God in our lives and in our world. It begins in a small way, but given time, it grows into something great. If you sow seeds, or watch plants grow, you have ample opportunities to pause in wonder at the whole process of growth. It takes place gradually and comes to fruition in beautiful flowers, majestic trees and abundant harvests.

Jesus uses this as a parable about growth of the Kingdom of God, the kingdom of right relationships with God and with one another. There too growth is slow, development unnoticeable, and then without realising it you have a mature relationship.

In the second parable, Jesus invites us to reflect on the importance and significance of relationships in our lives as they grow and mature. This is true both of our relationship with God and with others around us.

As we reflect on the readings today and their emphasis on growth as the work of the Lord, let us open our hearts and minds to the presence of God in our lives. This presence is the reason for our growth as Christians, both individually and as a community of faith
