**Second Sunday of Lent (Year C)**  
**12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> March 2022**

For one reason or another we may feel a bit low; a night without sleep; a recent piece of bad news; a family tension, or a lingering burden. Just as we need the hope of brighter, longer days ahead to bring us through the winter, we need times to feel the closeness of Christ. True for the three apostles at Tabor – true for us. It's a real help to feel and know the companionship of Christ who has himself, journeyed the heights and hollows: acclamations to make him King; attempts to banish and stone him; palms spread before him by a fickle crowd; a cross laid upon him and him upon it.

Just as Christ came down from the mountain, we know that life cannot be spent on a mountain top, beautiful but remote and distant. There was another height for Him to climb – Calvary this time, not Tabor. Calvary of the darkened sky, his face covered with sweat and blood, no clothes to dazzle – they had been taken away, thieves for companions, no heavenly voice, only the din of scoffers. But Tabor and Calvary have one thing in common – Jesus prays on both summits.

But for some today, God is missing, but not missed. It is not God who needs our prayer – we do. It's not enough to be in Jesus' company – we must 'Listen to Him' – in other words, to do as he says. By scripture, by his teaching, the informed conscience advice of Christian friends. For best results this Lent, follow the makers instructions.

**PRAYER** – Lord, give us a glimpse of the reality in which we are now living, enfolded in your goodness, and give us hope in the glory you have promised us. We ask this through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.
