Seventh Sunday of Easter (Year C)
28th & 29th May 2022

There is more immediate hope shared by the whole Church on this last Sunday before Pentecost. It is that the celebration of Pentecost in the liturgy next week will be an occasion of a fresh outpouring and empowering of the Holy Spirit. The Church is now in a state of waiting as the disciples waited in Jerusalem. Waiting to receive power in order to continue to be Jesus' witnesses to the very ends of the earth. One thing about Jesus' words to the disciples seems to be very significant. He told them 'wait'. Why was this important? The same idea is contained in the second reading of today from the book of Revelation: 'Let him who is thirsty come, let him who desires take the water of life without price' (Rev. 22:17). The water of life is another image for the Holy Spirit. It appears that the coming of the Spirit is linked to the waiting and the thirsting. Hence, each year, in these days between the Ascension and Pentecost, the Church teaches her children how to wait and thirst.

Do you desire more of the Holy Spirit; a greater empowering in order to be a witness for Jesus?

Do you desire a greater glimpse of the glory of Jesus?

Do you desire to share in it one day?

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And you shall renew the face of the Earth. O God who has taught the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant that by the gift of same Spirit we maybe always truly wise and ever rejoice in his consolation.
