Dear Friends,

We invite all our parishioners to join in celebrating the Ceremonies of this Holy Week. The Ceremonies are the steps in the journey of Jesus Christ for love of each one of us, not just for love of the crowd, but for love of each one of us individually.

We walk with Jesus on *Palm Sunday*. We join him in the Upper Room on *Holy Thursday* evening for the Last Supper – a meal is a sign of friendship, of acceptance, of love, of unity.
