Thirty First Sunday in Ordinary Time (A) 4th & 5th November 2023

Dear Friends,

In today's gospel Jesus has some harsh criticism to make of the scribes and Pharisees. He called them hypocrites, who preached one thing and did another. Which of us can truthfully say that our deeds always match our words? We cannot achieve either holiness or happiness by pretending to be what we are not. The moment we try to be what we are not we become unreal. Humility, on the other hand helps us to be ourselves and gives us the greatest freedom. Christ was able to see beneath the appearances.

He was able to see the inner person. What joy it gave him when he found a genuine person. When he met Nathanel he said, 'Here is a true Israelite, a man in whom there is not a trace of deceit or a shadow of pretence'. He gladly put up with Peter because he knew that in spite of his faults his heart was sound. He reached out to those who were lost, but who were desperately searching for something deeper, like the women at Jacob's well.

It caused him great sadness, however, to meet people like the Pharisees, people who were wasting their time on the exterior, and who had no time for the interior. It was St Thomas Merton who said, 'Many religious people are not saints because they never succeed in being themselves'. One of the ways the Lord supports us in living the gospel is through the community of faith. The Spirit is a work in each one of us. Our call is to keep learning from Christ our teacher, to be open to all he wants from us.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, deepen our faith that we may grow in your love and always serve you with generosity and a sincere heart. Amen.
