Today is our special day of celebration. We give thanks because Jesus came not just to his own people, but to all of us. The wise men who come from afar represent ourselves, the outsiders discovering their true home.

We too can make complicated journeys to God. Some of us begin quite close to him in families of faith and then drift away through the distractions and complexities of life. We lose the light and get ourselves into dreadful muddles which involve others as well as ourselves. Others of us, start out without much enlightenment anyway and only gradually stagger from the darkness. Others of us again are so confident, that we own the light, that we fail to see that it is but the false light of our own pride and self-righteousness. For all of us, the Magi are reassuring patrons. As we begin this new year, we pray for all who may be considering an abortion. Health and safety and fire precautions:

Last year a fire risk assessment was carried out. This was done by the health and safety consultants used by the diocese. Every parish in the diocese is involved. A number of requirements were highlighted, and most have been carried out. One however was the provision and training of fire marshals. The duties are not onerous but will ensure the ongoing safety of parishioners and the premises. A 45-minute training video has been provided by the H & S consultants, which covers, fire safety, evacuation, good housekeeping and use of fire extinguishers.
