Pentecost Sunday (B) 18th & 19th May 2024

Dear Friends,

In today's Gospel we see how Jesus says to his disciples "Receive the Holy Spirit". He breathes on them as a sign that through the Spirit they will share his life and continue his ministry of forgiveness. Jesus had not come to take their breath away but to breathe new life into them, the life of the Holy Spirit.

Today, Jesus calls us to come closer, to feel the breath of his spirit in our lives. Sometimes, like the breath of a mother on her baby, Jesus' Spirit is comforting and soothing. Yet the story of Pentecost reminds us that the Spirit also inspires and enlivens us to move on from contemplating God by ourselves in sharing our faith with others.

As St Paul says in our second reading, the Spirit works in many ways and our life of faith is made up of many aspects. We serve God not merely by meditating on his greatness but by opening ourselves to him, especially through the sacraments and by sharing the good news with others. In our lives there will always be some moments when we are overcome with wonder, with gratitude or even, with sorrow. It is important that we do not try to cling forever to these moments but allow the Holy Spirit to breath new life into us, so that God's purpose may be fulfilled in us.

Action Plan:

- Reflect on whether your personal prayers and beliefs leads you to reach out to others.
- What could be done in our church to make the wider community more aware of God's love and will for all of us?
- Keep the Parish Mission (9th 14th of June) in your hearts and minds as a way forward.
