The Baptism of the Lord (Year A) 10th & 11th January 2026

Dear Friends,

Today's feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the end of the Christmas season.

Baptism is the key theme of today's Gospel, which describes the baptism of our Lord. Jesus is without sin and has no need for the baptism of repentance that John preaches. Nonetheless, he undergoes baptism in solidarity with us sinners. When Jesus is baptised, the Father affirms Him as the beloved Son and the Holy Spirit descends upon Him. When we were baptised, we are drawn into this life of the Trinity.

God in His goodness dwells within us and we become temples of the Holy Spirit. Thus, Jesus opens the door of salvation to us, and by our Baptism, we pass through that door. But during our lives we often fail to retain the grace of God, that is, His divine life, in us. Serious sin can kill the life of grace in us. But the wonderful thing, which is being stressed, is that through repentance, the mercy of God can restore us to the life of grace. When we fall short and lose the life of grace, the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession / Penance), is the way that we experience God's mercy, and become a new creation again. Mercy is the tender love of God for the sinner who seeks Him.

Prayer:

Father, you sent your Son into the world to show us the way to you. Help us to follow the road he travelled with courage and steadfastness so that one day we may be where he is. We make our prayer through Christ our Lord.
